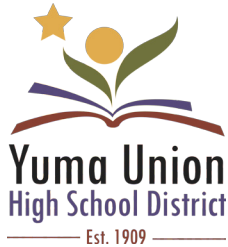

Arizona Western College

The Arizona Western College Nursing Department consists of the Certified Nursing Assistant program and the Associate Degree Nursing Program.

The Certified Nursing Assistant Program prepares the student to take the state examination to become a certified or licensed nursing assistant (CNA, LNA). The skills learned as a Certified Nursing Assistant can prepare the student for a long-term career in the nursing field.

The state and nationally accredited nursing program prepares students with a two-year Associate of Applied Science degree in Nursing (AAS). These graduates are eligible to seek licensure as a registered nurse (RN). AWC students can concurrently enroll in BSN programs with NAU-Yuma and ASU.
