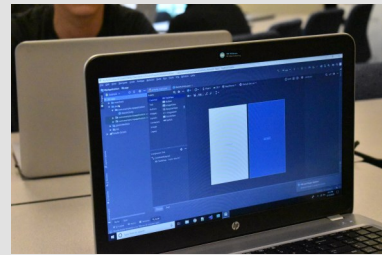


SOFTWARE DEVELOPMENT
