PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Phlebotomy and Laboratory Assistant professionals work throughout the healthcare industry in many different clinical environments. Phlebotomists specialize in the collection of blood for laboratory analysis and testing and serve patients by identifying the best method for retrieving specimens. Laboratory Assistant's work to support Laboratory Technicians in all aspects of the daily operations in medical laboratories. Students will learn the basics of phlebotomy and laboratory assisting including basic medical terminology and lab safety.

JOB OUTLOOK

The job growth rate for both Phlebotomists and Laboratory Assistant's is projected to grow a rate of 26% from 2016—2026 which is much faster than the average rate. Hospitals, diagnostic labs, doctors offices and blood donor centers will need Phlebotomist and Laboratory Assistant staff to perform collection of blood specimens.
